If you subscribe to the Mountaineer, you received a copy of HWA's most recent publication. After more than two months of planning and writing, it was distributed in early October as a 28-page insert. (This is why we have not issued a newsletter since our spring issue.) The insert was a deliverable for grants received from the EPA 319 Program and the NC Clean Water Management Trust Fund. The Pigeon River Fund also helped cover the cost overrun for printing.

The initial plans were for a ten-page document but that quickly grew to 28 pages as we realized just how much information there was to share. Topics included watershed planning, educational programs, stream restoration projects, pollution concerns and ways to reduce them, water quality sampling, greenways, restoration of native fish species, fresh-water bugs

and mussels, an overview of the watershed and many fun facts. Articles were contributed by the Haywood Soil and Water Conservation District, USDA NRCS, Pigeon River Fund, US Fish and Wildlife Service, NC Wildlife Resources Commission, County Recreation Department, and HWA staff and directors.
